1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Traffic Priority One• No limit on static, non-routeable IP addresses• Technical Support Priority One• Seat on HPWREN Advisory Board	\$51,784
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Traffic Priority Two• Up to 50 static, non-routeable IP addresses• Technical Support Priority Two	\$10,529
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Traffic Priority Three• Up to 10 static, non-routeable IP addresses• Technical Support Priority Three	\$1,748

*Rates not inclusive of indirect cost (IDC). IDC rates vary from 45-54.5% depending on funding source. UCSD's negotiated federal IDC rate will increase to 55% from 54.5% on 7/1/2012.
